OUR HISTORY:

The San Clemente Choral Society (SCCS) was created in the fall of 2004 as a community-based chorus for mixed voices. It continues to provide enriching cultural opportunities for both singers and audiences.

OUR MISSION:

The purpose of the SCCS is to provide an educational setting for community members to study choral music in a variety of styles. We rehearse weekly on Tuesday evenings and proudly provide concerts for the community at least twice a year. We love to sing all kinds of music and strive to include a variety at each concert.

OUR MEMBERS:

We range in age from 18 to 80+ and come from a wide variety of backgrounds. Some members have had a music career in their background while others simply enjoy singing and working together to improve their musical knowledge and skills.

AUDITIONS:

Auditions are not required. However, you should be able to carry and hold a tune and be willing to commit the time and effort needed to bring about a professional performance. This entails home practice to support the success of Tuesday night rehearsals.

FEES:

There is a one-time fee per season that consists of dues and music fees. Dues are estimated at \$60. Music fees have averaged \$25 - \$35. For current dues and fees, please contact membership@sccs-arts.org.

Potential new members are invited to attend an initial rehearsal to review our group and the season's music before committing to membership. Dues and music fees must be received at the next (subsequent) rehearsal. Dues and music fees are non-refundable.

ATTENDANCE:

Our fall and spring seasons each consist of 13 rehearsals culminating in an afternoon concert. Tuesday rehearsals are from 7:00 PM to 9:10 PM.

Attendance at all rehearsals is important! Members may miss no more than 3 rehearsals in a season. Please notify the Membership Chairman if you need to miss a rehearsal.

Attendance at the final rehearsal is mandatory.

DRESS CODE

Unless otherwise announced, the dress code for concert performances is:

Men

- Black dress shirt
- Black pants
- Red tie
- Black shoes and socks

Women

- Black pants or ankle length dress/skirt
- Black top covered bodice and sleeves
- Black dress shoes, black hose
- Simple jewelry

You will also need a 1.5 inch 3 ring black folder to hold your music during performances.

TICKET SALES:

Each member is asked to sell 10 tickets for the season. While selling tickets is not a requirement for membership, it is a vital to our financial sustainability. We appreciate each member's efforts to help meet this goal.
